The Belgrade Theatre in Coventry was the first purpose built theatre to open in Britain after the Second World War. Built as a conventional proscenium house it has not been substantially modified since. In recent years a studio space – B2 – has opened and our visit will see both the new space and the original main house. The main house production that day is “*One Night in November*” which opened in the studio some years ago, was revived in the studio and has now transferred to the main stage. Members of the production team will be on hand to talk about the changes that had to be made in the transfer.
