



#### What is the Gold Award for Theatre Technicians?

The Gold Award is a two day course designed to support the candidate for a role in which they will have responsibility for the management of the working environment and the practices therein.





Candidates wishing to pursue the Gold Award should have attained a similar level of understanding and comprehension as achieved by pursuing the Bronze and Silver courses. At Gold level candidates cover formal risk management skills required by managers, HODs or supervisors.

#### How is the course structured?



**DAY 1: Risk Management 1** - This module covers important aspects of the Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations, including roles in emergency/disaster plans and attitudes towards theatre safety.

DAY 2: Technical Standards for Places of Entertainment - exploring the guidance.
Risk Management 2- a practical session completing risk assessments.
Gold Award Assignment Briefing - planning your written report.

## What does the course cover?



- Health and Safety at Work etc. Act 1974
- Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations 1999
- Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations, Revised 1998 (PUWER)
- The Lifting Equipment and Lifting Operations Regulations 1998 (LOLER)
- Work at Height Regulations 2005
- Noise at Work Regulations
- Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005
- Licensing Act 2003 and Legislative Reform (Entertainment Licensing) Act 2015
- Construction (Design and Management) Regulations 2015
- Control of Substances Hazardous to Health Regulations

# Gold Award Assignment Briefing:

The assignment is a written report, to be completed within 3 months of the last course date and based on a management Safe System of Work, featuring the candidates workplace. It shoud be 2500-300 words. An assignment briefing and candidate discussion will take place with the course tutors. The assignment will be subject to external assessment by the Royal Conservatoire of Scotland.

## What will I be able to do at the end of the course?

- · Identify legal requirements for the provision of health and safety in the work place
- Identify sources of guidance for compliance with legal requirements
- Develop procedures to ensure adequate management of health & safety in the work place
- Undertake a comprehensive and detailed Risk Assessment
- Develop and record detailed method statements to achieve the control measures identified by a risk assessment.






