

When are they held?

Courses run throughout the year, particularly the Bronze Award, at locations around the UK.

The majority of our courses run during our “Summer School”, and are accredited by the Royal Conservatoire of Scotland.

CPD Course modules including Pyrotechnics usually run during this time. If you do not wish to take a full course, you can pick modules which relate more specifically to your training requirements.

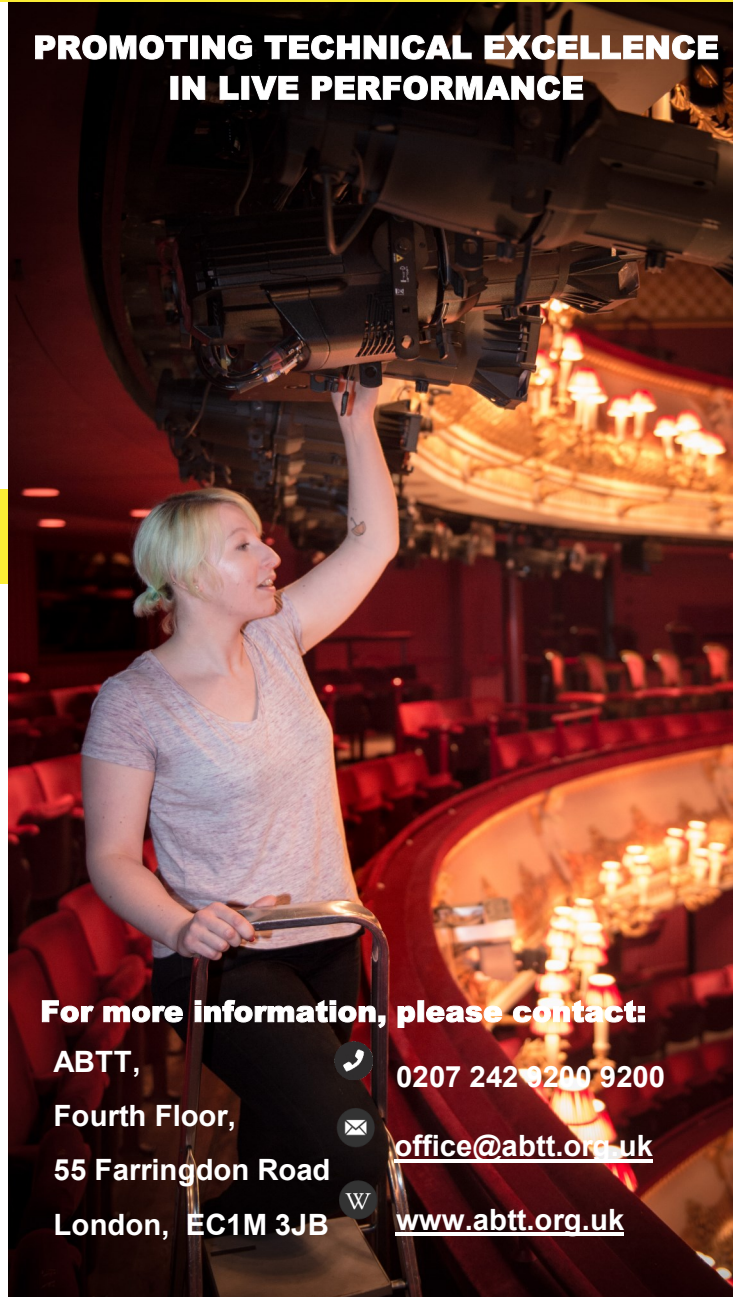
Alternatively, Theatres and Companies who are able to host ABTT training in their own venues may request training to be brought to them throughout the year, enabling employees to develop their skills in their own workplace.

Who can take the courses?

1. Both members and non-members are eligible to take these courses—it is often cheaper to become a member prior to booking.
2. Candidates should begin with the Bronze level course before proceeding on to the Silver or Gold, as this initial course covers and validates the skills necessary to work in a backstage role successfully.
3. Those with a significant amount of experience may be able to pursue the Silver or Gold Award if they can demonstrate they have attained a similar level of understanding. Candidates would have to pass the previous course's test in order to apply for the next level.
4. At Gold level the candidates cover formal risk management skills required by managers, HODs or supervisors.
