

ABTT BRONZE AWARD

Host Venue Requirements

Below is a list of subjects covered and the requirements (room size/equipment) needed for each day of hosting a Bronze Award Course.

All days require some way of showing a PowerPoint either via a projector or TV.

An introduction to Health and Safety and Manual Handling

- Classroom type space (can be on stage with tables and chairs), large dressing room/bar/meeting room.
- Large space to practice manual handling in and some equipment to carry. (steel decking/stage weights/boxes/or even chairs)

Safe use of Temporary Access Equipment

- Classroom type space (can be on stage with tables and chairs), large dressing room/bar/meeting room.
- Various steps/ladders/zargees to inspect/check. Tallescope. We will also look at MEWPs if the venue has one.

Ropes, Knots and Splicing

- Classroom type space (can be on stage with tables and chairs), large dressing room/bar/meeting room.
- Something to tie knots onto either fly bars or dress rails or suspended conduit.

Fundamentals of flying

- Classroom type space (can be on stage with tables and chairs), large dressing room/bar/meeting room.
- Access to the fly floor, possibly the grid and use of the (preferably) the counterweight fly system.

Electrical fundamentals

- Classroom type space (can be on stage with tables and chairs), large dressing room/bar/meeting room.
- Walk around the theatre/stage looking at incoming supplies/3-phase/single phase etc
